As you are probably aware, at the recent AGM held on 23rd April, the Trustees of the Society put forward a motion to dissolve the Hay Bridge Nature Reserve Society (HBNRS). On confirmation of the motion, the Trustees would then proceed to realise the assets of the Society and, after discharge of liabilities, donate the residue to the John Strutt Conservation Foundation (JSCF) for the purpose of Conservation and Education on the Hay Bridge Nature Reserve.

The motion was put to the members assembled for the AGM and was passed unanimously.

Given that there were no negative comments by email or post in response to the Trustees motion, which was circulated pre-AGM, it was further agreed by the Members assembled that the need for a further Special General Meeting of the Society to ratify the decision, as laid down in the Society's Constitution, was not required.

The Trustees and the HBNRS Committee will now work together with the JSCF to take the next steps in the process.
